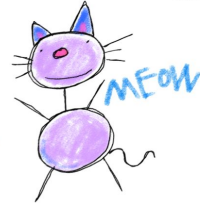

Spelling Test

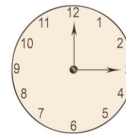
What Are We Learning About This Week?
