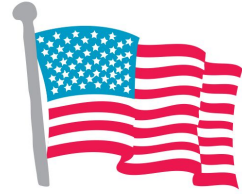

## What Are We Learning About This Week?

**Spelling:** The students are spelling words that end in -nk and -ng. There will be a test on Friday, November 9th. The word list is attached.

**Reading:** This week, the story, "Around the Pond: Who's Been Here?" will be read.

**Writing:** The students are participating in activities to help them learn how to organize the stories that they write.

**Math:** Money skills will be taught this week. The children are learning how to count pennies, nickels, dimes, and quarters. They will also compare money amounts.

**Science:** The students are learning about how living things grow and change. The life cycles of turtles and dragonflies will be discussed.

**Social Studies:** Information about elections and voting will be taught. The students will also practice the Pledge of Allegiance using sign language.
