What Are We Learning About This Week?

Spelling: The students will spell "Words Writers Use." There is a spelling test on THURSDAY, March 7th.

Reading: The students are participating in a literature study on the author Dr. Seuss (Theodore Geisel). They will read the following stories:

Monday: "The Cat in the Hat"
Tuesday: "Fox in Socks"
Wednesday: "Wacky Wednesday"
Thursday: "Happy Birthday to You" and "Oh the Places You Will Go!"

Math: The students will continue to learn about multiplication. They will also solve Dr. Seuss story problems.

Science: The story "Bartholomew and the Ooblick" will be read. Afterwards, the students will conduct a science experiment exploring the properties of solids and liquids by making ooblick.

Creative Arts: The students will sing "Happy Birthday" to Dr. Seuss, eat a special birthday cake, and make Cat in the Hat ice cream sundaes! They will also create large Cat in the Hat creatures to hang on the bulletin board.
